- 1. Who are the main characters in the story?
 - A. Jesus, Peter, and James
 - B. Jesus, and expert in the law, a Samaritan
 - C. Jesus, Judas, and Matthew

The answer is B.

2. What happened in the story?

Jesus told a parable of the good Samaritan to demonstrate what it means to be a good neighbor.

3. What was the problem?

A teacher of the law wanted to justify himself before Jesus and show Jesus that he was perfectly obeying God's law.

4. What was the solution to the problem?

Jesus told the parable of the Good Samaritan. The people that we expected to help the man who was robbed did not. But the stranger, the Samaritan, helped him.

1. What is the main theme of the lesson?

When people disappoint you and you feel alone, remember you have a heavenly Father, God, who has never failed you and never will. He loves you and has saved you.
