1. Who are the characters in the story?

The answer is C.
2. What happened in the story?
Peter and another disciple saw that Jesus' tomb was empty.
3. When did the story take place?
A. The first day of the week
B. The second day of the week
C. The third day of the week

The answer is A.
4. What was the problem?
The stone was removed from the entrance to Jesus' tomb.
5. What was the solution to the problem?
Jesus was risen from the dead.

Learn:

1. What is the main theme of the lesson?
It is important to trust God's Word and surround ourselves with other Christians who can help us mend our broken relationships.
2. What sin does this lesson teach you to confess? What do we fail to do? (the law)
We often do not respond to anger with love. We do not look to God for answers, instead we rely on ourselves alone.
3. Where do you see the love of God in the lesson? (the gospel)
Jesus rose from the dead to guarantee eternal life for us. He fixes broken relationships.
4. What does God teach you to do in the lesson?
We can go forward confidently with spiritual healing: a restored relationship with God, a restored relationship with ourselves and a restored relationship with others.
